S.R.O _____.- Whereas the Privatisation Commission is required to publish by notice in the official Gazette specified details of each completed privatisation transaction under section 26 of Privatisation Commission Ordinance, 2000.

Whereas the Privatisation of six (06) public properties have been completed.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the aforesaid provision and in exercise of the powers in this behalf, the Privatisation Commission hereby publishes this notice.

Section-A - Summary description of the transaction including name and address of the contracting party

The Federal Cabinet directed the Privatisation Commission to privatise a number of public properties/assets and approved the reserve price of the properties/assets under privatisation.

The advertisements for open public auction of the public properties/assets were published in the leading national dailies across the country on 8th March 2020. However, owing to the lockdown/restrictions due to coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the process was postponed. The process resumed on improvement in market conditions and advertisements were again published on 6th August 2020, 23rd August 2020 and 3rd September 2021.

Auctions were held during September 2020 in different cities of the county under the supervision of the auction committee constituted by the Privatisation Commission (PC) Board.
