**NOTIFICATION**

SRO No. \_\_\_\_\_ . In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Privatisation Commission Ordinance, 2000 (Ordinance No. LII of 2000), the Privatisation Commission hereby makes the following regulations to provide for meeting attendance fee to Members of its Board, namely:-

**CHAPTER - 1**

**GENERAL**

**SHORT TITLE, COMMENCEMENT AND APPLICATION**

1. Short title, commencement and application.— (1) These Regulations may be called the Privatisation Commission (Member's Attendance Fee) Regulations, 2014.
- (2) They shall come into force at once.
- (3) These Regulations shall apply to all the Members of the Board of Privatisation Commission.

**CHAPTER - 2**

**DEFINITIONS**

2. Definitions.— (1) In these Regulations, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:-
- i) 'Non-official Members' means a Member of the Board of Privatisation Commission other than official Members.
- ii) 'Official Members' means the Chairman, Secretary or such Members who are holding an office of Government of Pakistan or body established by Government of Pakistan.

(2) Words and expressions used but not defined in sub-regulation (1) of this regulation shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Privatisation Commission Ordinance, 2000.

### CHAPTER - 3

#### TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE/ MEETING ATTENDING FEE

3.01. Travelling Allowances/ Meeting Attending Fee (TA/MAF).- Whenever the Members travel to attending official meetings of the Privatisation Commission, i.e. Board Meetings, Transaction Committee Meetings, Negotiation Committee Meetings etc., as the case may be, they shall be entitled to Travelling Allowances/ Meeting Attending Fee as per regulation 3.02 or 3.03 of these Regulations.

3.02. Official Members.- Official Members shall be entitled to such Travelling Allowances/ Meeting Attending Fee as may be admissible to them under the rules made by the Government of Pakistan, Finance Division or the body established by the Government of Pakistan, in which they are holding office. They shall receive these Allowances from their own offices.

3.03. Non-official Members. - Non-official Members shall be entitled to the following:-

- (i) Meeting Attending Fee *Rs.50,000/-* for each meeting plus room rent paid in five star hotel for minimum single room rent and taxes for the days of meeting actually attended;
- (ii) Economy plus class air fare plus taxi charges from Residence to Airport at Headquarters and from Airport to the place of temporary residence at the outstation and vice versa.
- (iii) For travel through Railways, fare of Air conditioned class plus taxi charges from residence to station at Headquarters and from station to the place of temporary residence at outstation and vice versa.
- (iv) In case such members travel by road in personal car, *Rs.10/-* per km or Economy Plus Class Airfare to the destination whichever is less.
- (v) An amount of *Rs.5,000/-* per day is admissible to the non-official members of PC for transportation in case it is not provided by the Privatisation Commission.
- (vi) The Meeting Attending Fee would also be permissible for the Members who attend the meeting(s) via Video/Tele Conference.

## CHAPTER - 4

### PROCEDURE FOR TA/MAF CLAIM

4. Procedure for TA/MAF Claim.- The procedure for TA/MAF Claim shall be as under:-
- i) Claim to be supported by counterfoil of the ticket purchased and actual bills of a five star hotel in Karachi, Lahore, Quetta, Faisalabad and Peshawar and of any hotel in other places.
  - ii) Privatisation Commission may allow TA Advance if a request is so made by any Member. In such case, the advance will be adjusted through TA Bill.


## CHAPTER - 5

### MISCELLANEOUS

5. Chairman, Privatisation Commission may allow such other privileges/facilities to the non-official members as considered appropriate/essential by him in relation to business concerning Privatisation Commission.
